He was explaining each decision during the case and between the patients he gave us his lectures about the wrist. Every detail about the anatomy was elucidated. I had the opportunity also to work with Angel Ferreres and Alex Lluch. Three different surgeons and in some cases three different operations

methods and opinions. I have learned, that in most cases we have almost no real scientific evidence that one method is

superior to the other technique. It is always a question to make the right indication for the specific treatment for the patient. I think what really counts is the precise operation technique and the postoperative care for the patient.



Another Highlight was of course the visit of the anatomy lab of Marc. (Institute of Anatomy of the faculty of medicine University of Barcelona). We had the opportunity to watch the setup of a new experiment, and the measurement methods. Of course a precise lecture of the biomechanics of the wrist was included.
