- To observe a different healthcare system and to know how the 'SOS Main' organization works.



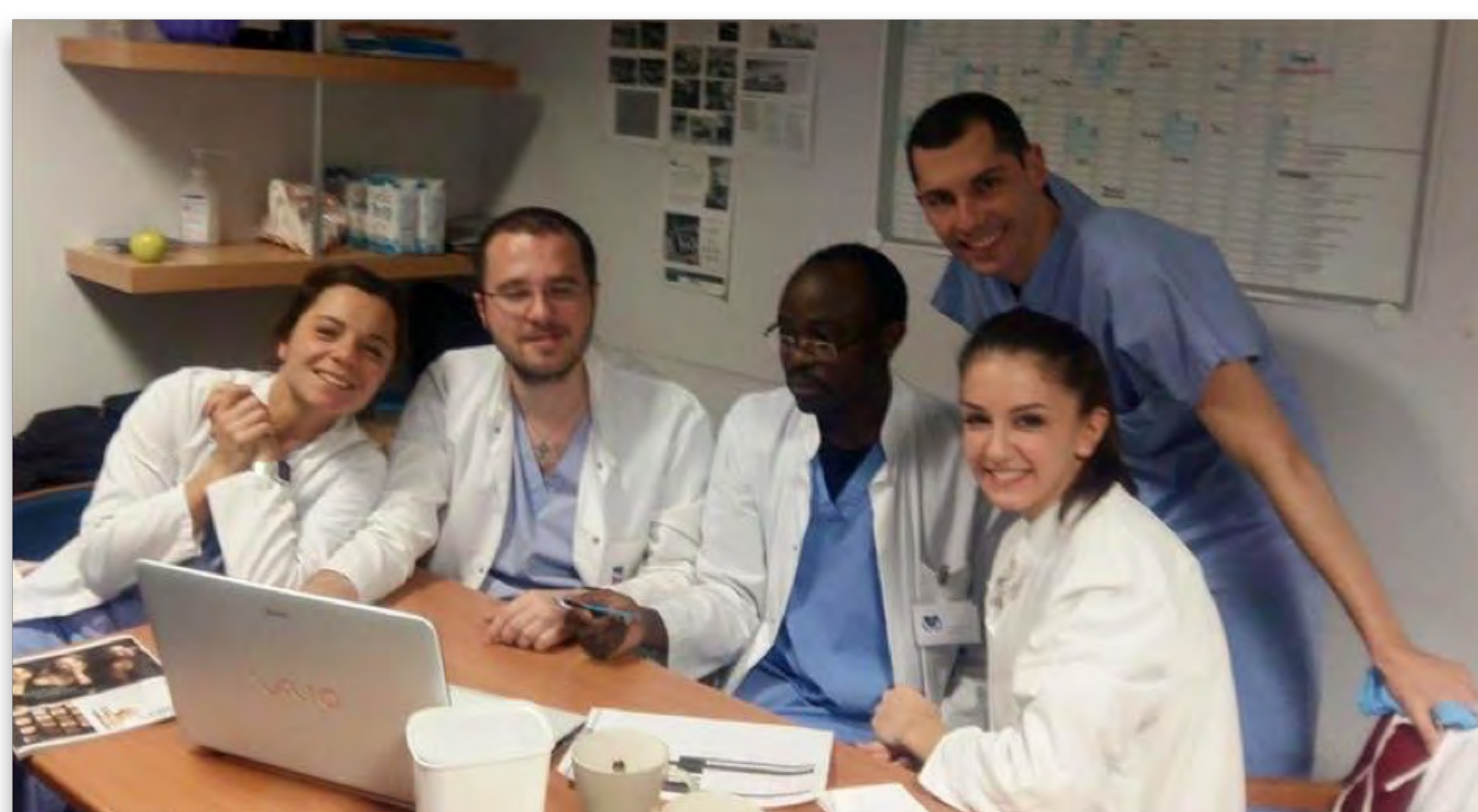
SOS MAIN STRASBOURG CENTRE

- Situated at Clinique des Diaconesses, in the heart of the "Petite France", a lovely neighborhood of Strasbourg.
- Five senior Hand Surgeons and four to five residents / interns.
- They attend 12000 emergencies per year and they carry out up to 7500 programmed surgeries each year.



DAILY ACTIVITY

- Residents in the Hand Department have three functions:
 - To be on-call for the SOS Main organization.
 - To support the senior surgeon in the postoperative wound healing consultation.
 - To assist the senior surgeon at the programmed surgery.
- Each quarter they celebrate a very interesting multidisciplinary consultation to discuss the more complex cases with the participation of other renowned surgeons as Prof Yves Allieu.
