



As part of my fellowship and training, I had the pleasure of visiting one of the leading hand surgery centres in Europe—*Institut De La Main, Paris.* My objectives for this fellowship were to obtain more experience in wrist arthroscopy, improve my understanding regarding its indications and techniques and observe different approaches in hand and wrist problems. The majority of my time during this visit was spent with *Prof. Christophe Mathoulin*, and it was my great honour to observe all his arthroscopic surgeries and assist him.

Prof. Mathoulin performed approximately 12–15 wrist arthroscopies per week, and I had the opportunity to observe several sophisticated arthroscopic procedures, including scapholunate ligament repair, foveal and peripheral TFCC tear repair, scaphoid nonunion, lunate bone cysts, scapholunate advanced collapse (SNAC) wrist management and STT arthrosis. **Prof. Mathoulin** also demonstrated some tips and tricks of the techniques that he described in scapholunate ligament repair and SNAC wrist management.






I was also able to observe and participate in several spastic and paralysed upper limb procedures with **Madame Caroline Leclercq**, such as hyperselective neurectomies, tendon transfers, tendon lengthening, tendoesis and arthrodesis.

During my 3-month training, I spent every day of the week in operating theatres. I also attended different types of hand and upper extremity surgeries with *Dr. Mathilde Gras, Dr. Ahlam Arnaout* and *Dr. Stephane Guero*. Some of these surgeries were as follows:

- Compressive neuropathies
- Tenolysis and pulley reconstructions
- LRTI for treatment of first CMC arthritis
- Hand and forearm fractures
- Congenital hand problems








Moreover, I formed invaluable friendships with other residents and fellows coming from every part of the world. In my spare time during the weekends, I had the chance to explore Paris, which is the centre of fashion, cuisine, art and architecture, and learn about the French culture.

One of the highlights of my visit was attending a symposium on peripheral nerve reconstruction. The symposium was chaired by *Prof. Alain Gilbert*, the former president of Institut De La Main. At the end of my training, I attended the *14th IFSSH Congress* in Berlin, which provided a theoretical reinforcement of my experience in Paris.








