
Objectives


- ✓ To expand my knowledge in the treatment of brachial plexus injuries

SURGICAL TRAINING

I had the privilege to visit the Clinical Rehabilitation Hospital, Cluj-Napoca one of leading centers for complex hand surgery in Romania. The majority of my visit was spent observing and scrubing in with prof. Alexandru Georgescu. I had opportunity to observe and learn his own developed techniques management of mallet finger and zone II flexor tendon injures, which I already had opportunity to apply successfully in the center were I work. I learnt his management of general hand pathologies such as: Dupuytren's disease, entrapment neuropathies, carpal tunnel, trigger finger release, metacarpal and phalanx fractures pinning. Had the opportunity to observe this assessment of paralyzed upper limbs, brachial plexus injures, scaphoid non-union, of post-traumatic sequelae in hand, soft tissues coverage after tumor resections and burns, local flaps and skin grafting, use of free flaps for upper limb defects coverage, nerve grafts after upper limb trauma.

Prof. Georgescu shared his long term results from his treated cases and his decision making process for each specific case.
