
- Arthroscopic assisted distal radius fracture reduction and ostheosynthesis

- MCPJ fusion
- Carpal tunnel release (open technique)
- Diagnostic arthroscopy




The team creates friendly environment and all the surgeons are very available to answer all the questions discussing experiences and ideas.
